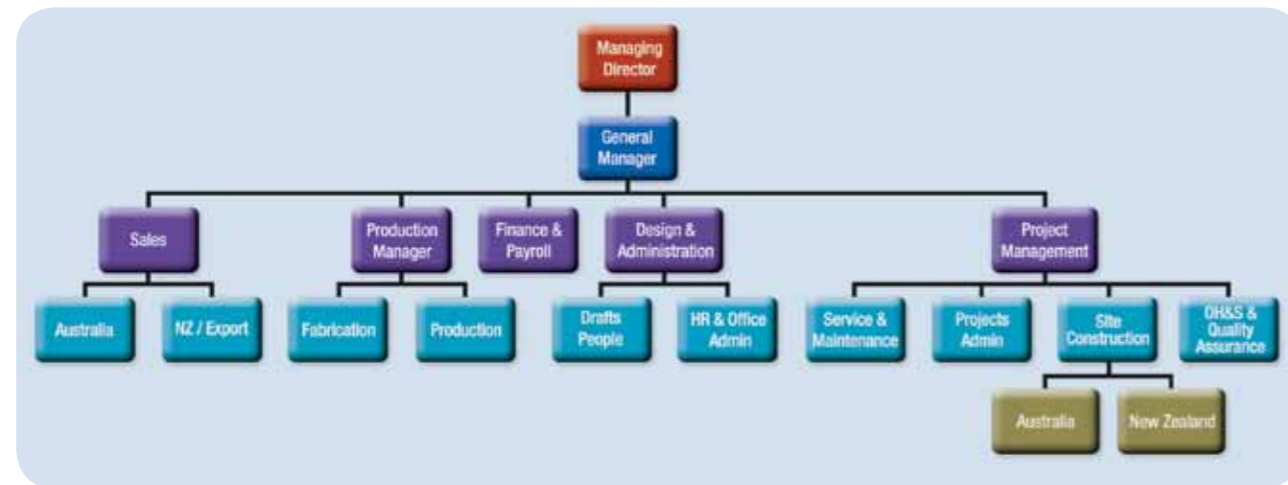


The Management

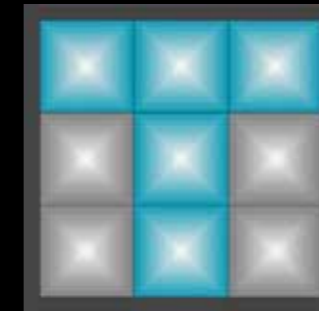

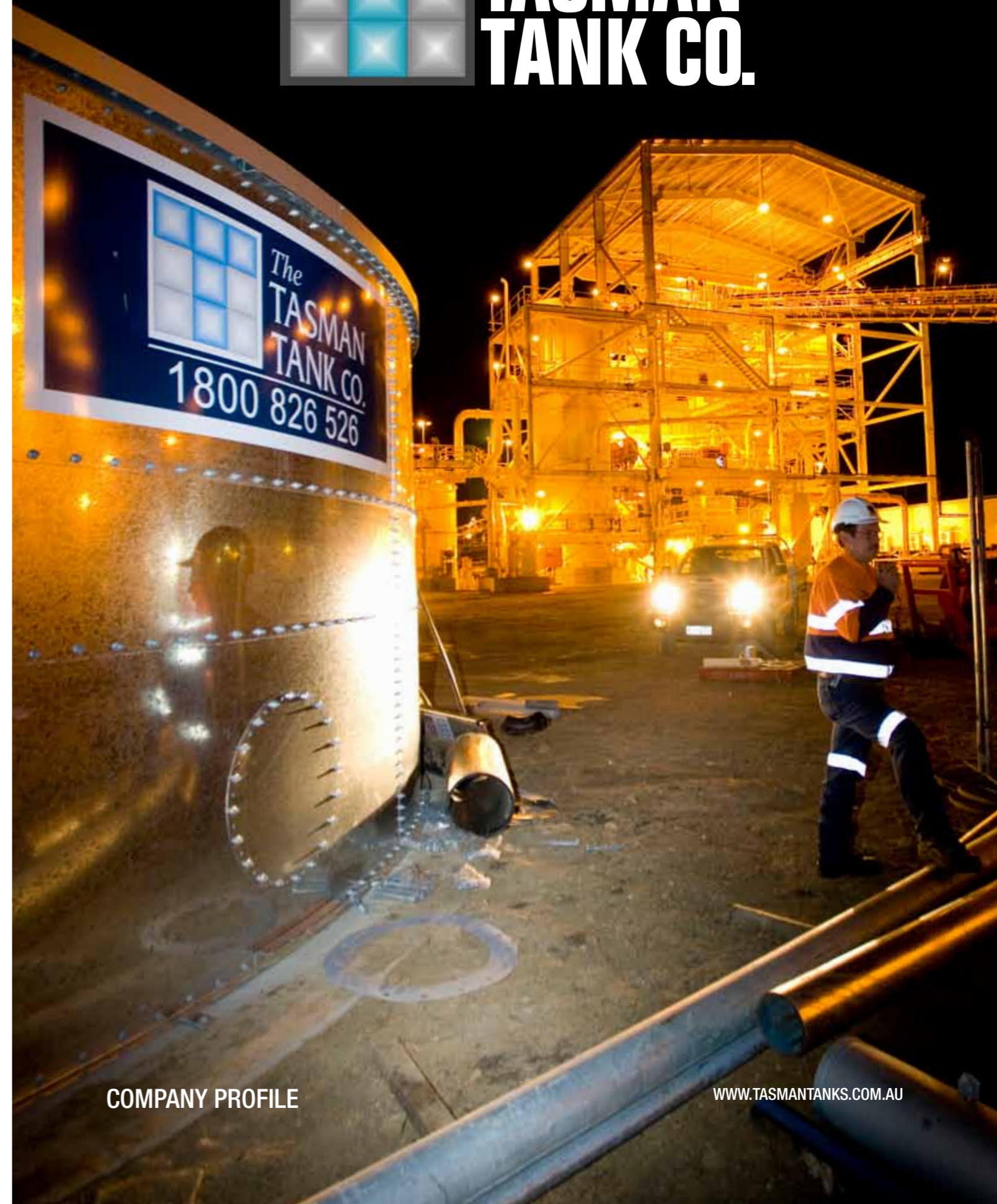
